

HANOI, HUE, DA NANG, HOCHIMINH, SIEM REAP, BANGKOK



Grand Palace, Bangkok

Day 1 Depart Hometown → Tokyo

Today begin your vacation by Japan airline to Tokyo.

Day 2 Arrive Tokyo → Hanoi

Crossing the International dateline and enjoy in flight services on board. Connect flight for Hanoi via Tokyo. Upon arrival in Hanoi, meet and greet at airport and transfer to hotel.

Day 3 Hanoi

Begin full days tour to Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum, his former residential house. One pillar-pagoda, Tran Quoc Temple built in 11 century as Vietnam's first University. Promenade in 36 old quarters and a cultural show of Water Puppet will be followed.

Day 4 Hanoi → Ha Long → Hanoi

Morning transfer to Ha Long for 4 hours boat trip through majestic Ha Long Bay. Enjoy beautiful landscape of Ha Long with grottos which formed by Islands and Islets. Explore caves walks and enjoy on board seafood lunch. Return transfer to Hanoi.

Day 5 Hanoi → Hue

Take short flight to Hue. You are met in Hue and tour starts to visit Imperial Citadel and its Forbidden Purple City from where Nguyen Dynasty ruled between 1802 to 1945. Dinner cruise with traditional music show on Huong (Perfume) River.

Day 6 Hanoi

Overland to the memorial hall of King Khai Dinh (ruled 1916 - 1925) and King Minh Mang (ruled 1820 - 1840) where the contrast between oriental and occidental architectures is shown. Browse around at Dong Ba market where you will find gifts items and conical Vietnam hats.

Day 7 Hue → Da Nang → Hoi An

By scenic coach drive to Da Nang over the Pass of Ocean Clouds and photographic village of Lang Co Lagoon. Continue to Hoi An, visiting Hoi An ancient town, Japanese style bridge temple, Mr. Tran's old house with brief stop in hand-made lantern workshop. Rest of day at your own leisure.

🏠 Hoi An Beach Resort 4* or similar

Day 8 Hoi An → Da Nang → Ho Chi Minh

Transfer to Da Nang airport and take morning flight to Ho Chi Minh. You are welcomed at airport and followed by city sightseeing to Notre Dame Cathedral, Municipal Post Office and Reunification Palace.

Day 9 Ho Chi Minh → Cu Chi → Ho Chi Minh

Coach tour to Cu Chi Tunnels, which is 75 km North West from Ho Chi Minh city. A network of tunnels dug by guerrillas with 3 levels stretching over 200 km long were the shelter of 16,000 fighters during war. Return to Ho Chi Minh city to visit War Remnant Museum, Thien Hau Temple and Binh Tay market.

Day 10 Ho Chi Minh → Mekong Delta → Ho Chi Minh

A day trip starting by scenic 2 hours drive through fertile paddy field to My Ty, the bustling town of the Mekong Delta, experience the daily life of Mekong Delta residence in water village. Return to Ho Chi Minh, take in free time on own.

Day 11 Ho Chi Minh → Siem Reap • Angkor Wat

Take morning flight for Siem Reap. You are met by local English speaking guide and transferred to hotel. After lunch will proceed for Fabled temples of Angkor, the ancient capital of the Khmer Empire. Visit South gate of Angkor Thom, the famous Bayon, Baphuon, the Terrace of Elephants and Terrace of the Leper King. Take time for sunset picture over Angkor Wat before returning to hotel.

🏠 Angkor Century Hotel 4* or similar

Day 12 Siem Reap • Angkor Wat

Second day to explore the wondrous ancients starting from Grand circuit taking in Pre Rup, East Mebon, Neak Poan and Preah Khan. In the afternoon continue to visit the fabulous Ta Prohm Temple, embraced by the roots of enormous fig trees and gigantic creepers.

Day 13 Siem Reap → Bangkok

Early morning watch the sunrise in Angkor Wat. Return hotel for breakfast. Spend half day on a boat trip in Tonle Sap Lake; visit typical floating villages and a stop in Siem Reap market for souvenirs before transfer to Siem Reap airport for Bangkok. Taking short flight to Thailand and you are met in Bangkok airport with transfer to hotel for accommodation. Tonight enjoy dinner show in Siam Niramit. 90 minutes showcase of Siam history. Browse around Thai style farmer village garden with experience of Thai message.

🏠 Holidays Inn Silom Hotel 4* or similar

Day 14 Bangkok

Experience 4 hours city sightseeing to Grand Palace and Emerald Buddha and gourmet local lunch before to end your tour. Tonight you are free on your own to explore Bangkok at ease, or make last minutes shopping before returning home. Dinner will be on your own.

Day 15 Bangkok → Tokyo → Hometown

Farewell to your team member and say goodbye to friendly driver and guide. Transfer to airport for flight home.
